## Today is Law Day 2015

**VANCOUVER, BC** – The Canadian Bar Association, BC Branch (CBABC) announces that today Thursday, April 16 is Law Day; part of a week of province-wide celebrations, including public education law classes, courthouse tours, mock trials, Legal Health Checks, and a public speaking contest for high school students.

Law Day 2015 is a national celebration of the signing of Canada's *Charter of Rights and Freedoms* and an opportunity to learn more about the justice system, what the legal community does, and what legal resources are available. This year's theme is *Access to Justice: What does it mean to YOU?* Law Day events across Canada are made possible through the efforts of hundreds of lawyers who generously donate thousands of hours of volunteer time.

"Law Week events provide British Columbians opportunities to learn about the justice system in an engaging and interesting manner," said Alex Shorten, BC Branch President. "The CBABC is pleased to provide many varied opportunities to explore how the justice system functions. We invite all British Columbians to attend these free events across the province."
